PUBLIC HEALTH (COVID-19 EMERGENCY POWERS) (PHASED RE-OPENING)
AMENDMENT (NO. 2) REGULATIONS 2022

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Her Excellency the Governor, on the advice of the Minister responsible for health, and in exercise of the power conferred by section 107B of the Public Health Act 1949, makes the following Regulations:

Citation

1 These Regulations, which amend the Public Health (COVID-19 Emergency Powers) (Phased Re-opening) Regulations 2021 (“the principal Regulations”), may be cited as the Public Health (COVID-19 Emergency Powers) (Phased Re-opening) Amendment (No. 2) Regulations 2022.

Amends regulation 2

2 In regulation 2 of the principal Regulations, delete the definition of “Student 7-day Pass”.

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Amends regulation 5

3 In regulation 5 of the principal Regulations, in paragraphs (1), (2), (3) and (5) delete “20” in each place and substitute “100”.

Amends regulation 6A

4 In regulation 6A of the principal Regulations, delete paragraph (1)(a).

Amends regulation 8A

5 In regulation 8A of the principal Regulations, delete paragraph (a).

Revokes regulation 12A

6 Regulation 12A of the principal Regulations is revoked.

Revokes regulation 17A

7 Regulation 17A of the principal Regulations is revoked.

Amends regulation 17AA

8 In regulation 17AA(1)(a) of the principal Regulations, delete “20” and substitute “100”.

Commencement

9 These Regulations shall come into effect at 12 noon on 4 February 2022.
