**Re: RESPONSE TO PARLIAMENTARY QUESTIONS**

I write in response to the parliamentary questions raised by MP Dennis Lister JP, MP dated December 7<sup>th</sup> 2015. Accordingly, I can advise as follows:

**Q1.** During a news interview regarding the backlog of trash collection the Minister indicated that two mechanics from the Ministry were overseas for training with the manufacturer of the trash trucks. Would the Honourable Minister please inform this Honourable House as to the specifics of that training?

**Answer:** The training is for diagnosis and repair of the Isuzu refuse vehicles with specific training on the engine, transmission, braking and Exhaust Gas Recirculation (EGR) systems. As a point of clarification, during the news interview the Minister indicated three members of staff are scheduled to attend training in February 2016.

**Q2.** Would the Honourable Minister please inform this Honourable House as to the duration of that training?

**Answer:** The training is scheduled for four days.
