INTERNATIONAL SANCTIONS (POLICING AND CRIME ACT) AMENDMENT
REGULATIONS 2017

The Minister responsible for justice, in exercise of the power conferred by section 2 of the International Sanctions Act 2003, makes the following Regulations:

Citation

1 These Regulations, which amend the International Sanctions Regulations 2013 (“the principal Regulations”), may be cited as the International Sanctions (Policing and Crime Act) Amendment Regulations 2017.

Revokes and replaces regulation 2

2 Regulation 2 of the principal Regulations is revoked and replaced with the following—

“Application

2 An Order (made by the Privy Council as a United Kingdom Order in Council) listed in Schedule 1 to these Regulations, whether or not it has been extended to Bermuda, and any amendments made from time to time to the Order, shall have the force of law in Bermuda and shall be construed and applied as if—

- (a) Schedule 1 to the Order (which lists the territories to which the Order extends); or
- (b) in the case of the Policing and Crime Act (Financial Sanctions) (Overseas Territories) Order 2017, the Schedule to the Order (which lists the territories to which the Order extends),

includes Bermuda as a territory to which the Order extends.”.

Amends Schedule 1

3 Schedule 1 to the principal Regulations is amended by inserting after paragraph (zn) the following—

“ (zo) Policing and Crime Act (Financial
Sanctions) (Overseas Territories) Order
2017 11 October 2017 ”.
