GOVERNMENT FEES AMENDMENT REGULATIONS 2026

The Minister of Finance, in exercise of the power conferred by section 2 of the Government Fees Act 1965, makes the following Regulations:

Citation

1 These Regulations, which amend the Government Fees Regulations 1976, may be cited as the Government Fees Amendment Regulations 2026.
