MARINE BOARD (PILOTAGE DUES) AMENDMENT REGULATIONS 2021

The Minister responsible for marine and ports services, in exercise of the power conferred by section 103 of the Marine Board Act 1962, makes the following Regulations:

Citation

1 These Regulations, which amend the Marine Board (Pilotage Dues) Regulations 1972 (the “principal Regulations”), may be cited as the Marine Board (Pilotage Dues) Amendment Regulations 2021.

Amends regulation 5

2 Regulation 5 of the principal Regulations is amended by deleting “ten dollars per movement” and substituting “ten dollars and fifty cents per movement”.

Revokes and replaces Schedule

3 The Schedule to the principal Regulations is revoked and replaced with the following—

“SCHEDULE

(regulation 1)

Port of destination or departure	Dues payable per metre of draught
St. George, including Five Fathom Hole, Murray’s Anchorage and Esso Oil Docks	\$144
Dockyard, including the anchorage at Grassy Bay	\$201
Hamilton, including anchorages and berths in the Great Sound and Port Royal Bay	\$214
Port to port shift	\$144
Shift within a port, using a pilot	\$98
Pilotage detention	\$117 per hour or part thereof.
