GOVERNMENT FEES AMENDMENT (NO. 2) REGULATIONS 2021

BR / 2021

The Minister of Finance, in exercise of the power conferred by section 2 of the Government Fees Act 1965, makes the following Regulations:

Citation

1 These Regulations, which amend the Government Fees Regulations 1976 (the “principal Regulations”), may be cited as the Government Fees Amendment (No. 2) Regulations 2021.

Amends Head 14

2 Head 14 (Children Act 1998) of the principal Regulations is amended—

(a) by deleting paragraph (3) and substituting—

- “ (3) Issuing a licence under section 68 or renewing a licence under section 69 to operate a day care centre that has—

Amends Head 24

3 Head 24 (Electricity Act 2016) of the principal Regulations is amended by inserting after paragraph (5)—

- “ (6) Authorisation to a Large Scale Self-Supply Licence holder to engage in Large Scale Self-Supply Electricity Generation (greater than 0.5 megawatts of installed electricity generation capacity) \$3,400 per megawatt per annum of installed electricity (payable quarterly) ”.
